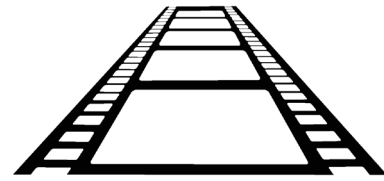


## Competition Terms and Conditions

1. 'Backtrack Anti Trespassing Competition' is promoted by Community Rail Lancashire Ltd. (Registered No. 9999437) of Accrington Railway Station, Eagle Street, Accrington, Lancashire, BB5 1LJ.

2.1 Participants of the competition are asked to send their entry via WeTransfer to [info@downdheline.org.uk](mailto:info@downdheline.org.uk). Participants must have parental approval before submitting their entry. If an entrant chooses to share their creation on social media 11-13s must ask their parent/carer's permission to use their social media account to share their entry. By sending a competition entry you have given us permission to use it.

2.2 There will be 1 prize winner for each category - video, storyboard, script, song, school/group entry and greatest impact on social media. Prize details can be found on [www.downdheline.org.uk/projects/backtrack](http://www.downdheline.org.uk/projects/backtrack)

3.1 To enter the competition all entries must be submitted with a completed entry form and media consent form by 23:59 GMT on Wednesday 30th September 2020.

3.2 The competition will run from 01/06/20 4:00PM GMT until 30/09/20 23:59 GMT. Entries received outside this time period will not be considered. Community Rail Lancashire Ltd. reserves the right in its absolute discretion to extend the closing date where the entries received are of insufficient quality or quantity.

3.3 No entry fee is required, however, you are responsible for the cost (if any) of issuing your competition entry.

3.4 We will not accept:

- (a) responsibility for competition entries that are lost, mislaid, damaged or delayed in transit, regardless of cause, including, for example, as a result of any postal failure, equipment failure, technical malfunction, systems, satellite, network, server, computer hardware or software failure of any kind; or
- (b) proof of posting or transmission as proof of receipt of entry to the competition.

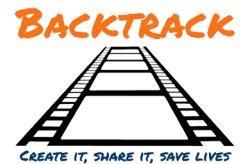
3.5 By submitting an entry, you are agreeing to be bound by these terms and conditions.

4.1 The competition is open to individuals aged 11-18, except:

- (a) employees of community rail partnerships;
  - (b) individuals who are professionally connected with the competition or its administration;
- or
- (c) members of the immediate families or households of (a) and (b) above.

4.2 In entering the competition, you confirm that you are eligible to do so and eligible to claim the prize should you win. We may require you to provide proof that of eligibility.

4.3 We will not accept competition entries:

- (a) that have been automatically generated by computer;
- (b) that have been completed by third parties or in bulk;
- (c) that are illegible, have been altered, reconstructed, forged or tampered with;
- (e) that are incomplete;
- (f) that have been filmed on location outside of your home, garden or school/group (if you are attending school) during 'Covid-19 Lock Down'.
- (g) that are not suitable to show to young people in school (e.g. too graphic).

4.4 We reserve all rights to disqualify you if your conduct is contrary to the spirit or intention of the competition e.g. is has been filmed on location outside of your home, garden or school/group during 'Covid-19 Lock Down' or does not comply with government lockdown guidelines at the time of filming.

5.1 Prize winners will be decided by a panel of judges from all the valid competition entries received in accordance with these terms and conditions.

5.2 Prizes are subject to availability. There is no cash alternative for the prizes. Prizes are not negotiable other than set out in the terms above or transferable.

5.3 We will send the full names of the judges to anyone who writes within one month after the closing date of the competition requesting details of the judges and who encloses a self-addressed envelope to the address set out in clause 1. A list of names of the judges can be requested via email at [info@downtheline.org.uk](mailto:info@downtheline.org.uk) with the wording "Backtrack Anti-Trespassing Competition" in the subject line, from the closing date for a period of 30 days.

6.1 The winners of the Competition will be announced on Friday 23rd October 2020.

6.2 The decision of the judges nominated by us is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.

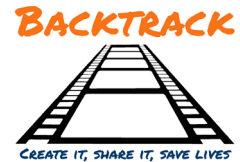
6.3 We will contact the winners personally as soon as practicable after the announcement date, using the telephone number or email address provided with the competition entry. We will not amend any contact information once the competition entry form has been submitted.

6.4 We will send the name and county of the winners to anyone who writes within one month after the closing date of the competition requesting details of the winners and who encloses a self-addressed envelope to the address set out in clause 1.

7.1 We will make all reasonable efforts to contact the winners. If you are the winner of a prize, you will have 7 days from the announcement date to claim the prize by responding to the email or phone call made by us after the announcement date. If you do not claim the prize by this date, your claim will become invalid. We reserve the right to offer the prize
